Cascade Attachments - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They began as a small machine shop at first employing four people. Sales for their first year of operation totaled \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and various components. During five years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 workers and their yearly sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Now, Cascade is amongst the top international manufacturers in the material handling business.

Design and production of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively engage in new business possibilities. Throughout the final 60 years, the business of material handling has grown into a very sophisticated field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade currently continues to develop as the best provider of forklift accessories and different associated products. The business feels assured in their potential to be able to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining competitive in the global market.

During the 1950's, Cascade started to make, design, and promote its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was made in 1956, to be able to accommodate all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's present head office. After 15 years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next production facility was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the business recognized interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Then in the year 1965, the company went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing amenities throughout the continental US to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already existing plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are fabricated internationally due to numerous subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This facility is made to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 after buying five companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international best in forks.
